II. Approval of Minutes from May 3rd, 2022- All-in favor.

III. Maintenance Reports

A. Dave Heinen, Grounds Maintenance Contract- After a meeting at Eisenhower Pond the hillside has been cleaned up some. Once locates are completed the viburnum along Tomahawk will be pulled. The island baldcypress has been trimmed up and all plantings are in except for the lilies. Have been doing some weeding in general and will spray the miscellaneous arrowhead that remain.

B. John Mclenon, Rosehill Gardens – The annuals are in, and the rain has been co-operating. Brookwood and State Line Rd. has been redone and will add annuals where the yews were pulled.

Kauffman Island- Is mostly complete, more annuals will be added to the south side. Ms. Gibson added that we're still exploring low wall options at this location. Yews have been added to hide the electrical as well.

Old Riss- Is complete

Wenonga Rd. and Wenonga Terr.- Is complete and looking sharp.

C. Jesse Kirk, City Arborist- We continue to monitor trees impacted by the Tomahawk Construction. Have flagged the Moody's property to finalize the plantings for the shelf restoration project. Have had lots of debris at the low water crossings from the recent rains.

V. Team and Special Project Reports

A. Indian Hills Homes Association (IHHA)- The island at Wenonga Rd. and Wenonga Terr. is completed! Ms. Gibson questioned if we had fully been reimbursed and Mr. Carroll responded that we are awaiting one final invoice.



B. Mission Hills Homes Company (MHHC) – The drive around has been completed and most of the comments center around weeding. We continue to work on the right path forward for Colonial Garden. Mr. Carroll mentioned that the check from the insurance company for the damaged fountain is in transit. Ms. Gibson added that we will continue to do significant research prior to replacing to ensure we do it right.

C. Tomahawk Roads Homes Association (TRHA)- Have completed the drive around and the annuals look great! Lots of areas need weeding. We're considering re-doing the island at Overhill and 70th Terr. Eisenhower Pond is progressing, will remove viburnum in front of the stone wall on the south end and replace with roses. Will be moving the Fisher boy statue from 70th St. and Overhill Rd. to the island in the pond.

The cul-de-sac at 70th St. and Belinder Ave. needs re-done.

Will use the boxwoods at the 67th Terr. and High Dr. Island as an experiment, try stair stepping them to reduce "legginess".

Duck weed at Eisenhower Pond continues to be a concern.

Justin Carroll added that we've been in discussion with WaterOne regarding options to add irrigation to the south end of the pond as it was determined that sucking the water from the pond would create a maintenance nightmare.
