

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-II

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MISSION HILLS, KANSAS TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX RATE EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE.

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Mission Hills, Kansas (the "City") was calculated as 21.270 mills by the Johnson County Clerk;

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate;

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2025, the Governing Body approved a motion calling and providing for notice of a public hearing on September 8, 2025 on the Governing Body's intent to levy a property tax exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate;

WHEREAS, the City Clerk sent a written Notice of Hearing to Exceed Revenue Neutral Rate and Budget Hearing (the "Notice") to the Johnson County Clerk on July 15, 2025, and caused the Notice to be published in *The Legal Record* on August 26, 2025;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body held a public hearing on September 8, 2025 allowing all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard an opportunity to give oral testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City, having heard testimony, still finds it necessary to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MISSION HILLS:

Section 1. The City shall levy a property tax rate of 22.766, which exceeds the Revenue Neutral Rate of 21.270 mills.



The City Administrator and other officials and representatives of the City are hereby authorized and directed to take such actions and to execute any other documents, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.


RESOLUTION NO. 2025 - JJ
